The Dominican Republic is a small country in Central America. It is bordered by Haiti to the west, by Santo Domingo to the east, and has the Caribbean Sea as its northern coast. In recent years, it has become a popular tourist destination due to its welldeveloped tourist industry and beautiful beaches. Tourists come from all around the world to enjoy activities such as sunbathing on beautiful beaches or exploring caves that contain stalactites and stalagmites. In order to visit this country, tourists need a passport from their home countries as well as a visa for travel from The Dominican Republic's embassy abroad. Also, the Dominican Republic is not part of the Schengen Agreement. Citizens of Canada, United States, and other countries who are planning to visit the country do not require a visa. It is important for people to take into consideration that if they are coming to visit The Dominican Republic, they should take advantage of having their passport with them at all times. This helps prevent them from being detained or inspected by police officers. Other things that may cause problems for tourists include passports that are damaged, lost or stolen. Also, tourists need to take their visits carefully because they may be physically harmed or even killed if they end up in dangerous situations like standoffs against criminals. There is also a difference between visiting and living in this country. Tourists who come to the Dominican Republic for a vacation usually do not need a visa or passport if they stay for less than thirty (30) days. Of course, they will need to present their valid passports upon arrival to the country. Visitors must pay an entrance fee of thirty (30) dollars and cannot be more than sixty (60) days apart from one another. If the tourist wishes to stay for more than sixty (60) days, they must apply for residency at the Immigration Office in Santo Domingo the first week after the first two months have passed. At this point, they can apply for a work permit. If their application is approved, they will be able to work and receive the rights of a Dominican citizen. However, they must still be able to prove that they have enough money to support themselves and any dependents that may come with them. If the tourist does not apply for residency within thirty (30) days of paying all of their taxes and fees plus taxes, they will no longer be allowed to stay in the country. Tourists who intend on staying in The Dominican Republic for more than one year need to renew their visa before their current visa expires. They should be aware that if they do not renew their visa, they will need to apply for a new one at a Dominican embassy or consulate outside of the country. Generally, tourists who come to the country purely for a vacation will enjoy joining in with local customs. They may participate in activities such as going to salsa classes, purchasing souvenirs from street vendors and checking out the many beaches that this beautiful country has to offer.
